- Demonstrated ability to organize, develop outcomes and appropriate outcomes measures, problem solve, and provide results
- Experience with QA/program evaluation
- Sufficiently familiar with HUD program grants

The QA professional will perform a program evaluation review annually to ensure the service coordinator is providing the assistance that residents require.

QA Tasks:

- Review service coordinator's files
- Review service coordinator's activities
- Conduct resident survey
- Make programmatic recommendations (if needed)
- Help the service coordinator establish and sustain partnerships (if needed)
- Provide technical assistance and guidance (if needed)
- Complete program evaluation report
